Keys to Effective Intervention

- 1. Supplementary daily small group instruction
- 2. Research supported approaches.
- 3. Low student/teacher ratio (recommended 3:1 for younger students and 4:1 for older students)
- 4. Accelerated progress and flexible entry and exit.
- 5. Structured and systematic framework for instruction.
- 6. Fast-paced, carefully designed and sequenced lessons.
- 7. Explicit teaching for reading comprehension.
- 8. Explicit teaching for reading fluency.
- 9. Carefully designed sequence for phonics/word study
- 10. Writing about reading.
- 11. Engaging, specially written and sequenced collection of leveled texts
- 12. Systematic assessment, progress-monitoring, and record-keeping.
