

Keys to Effective Intervention

1. Supplementary daily small group instruction
2. Research supported approaches.
3. Low student/teacher ratio (recommended 3:1 for younger students and 4:1 for older students)
4. Accelerated progress and flexible entry and exit.
5. Structured and systematic framework for instruction.
6. Fast-paced, carefully designed and sequenced lessons.
7. Explicit teaching for reading comprehension.
8. Explicit teaching for reading fluency.
9. Carefully designed sequence for phonics/word study
10. Writing about reading.
11. Engaging, specially written and sequenced collection of leveled texts
12. Systematic assessment, progress-monitoring, and record-keeping.
